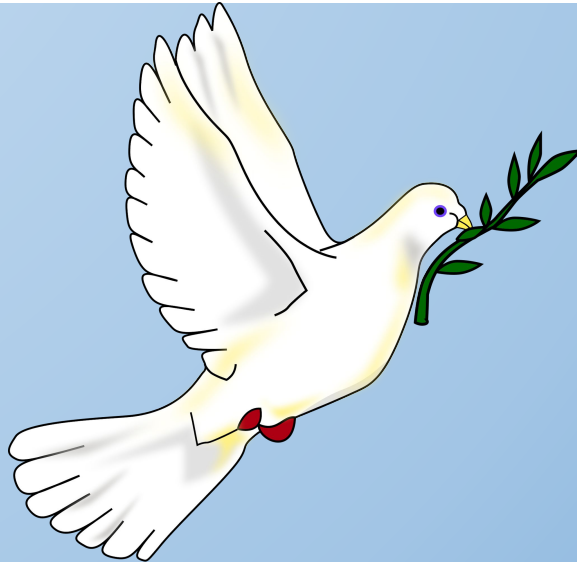
What is Global Goal 16?

Peace means, freedom from disturbance but, sadly not all of the world is living in peace.



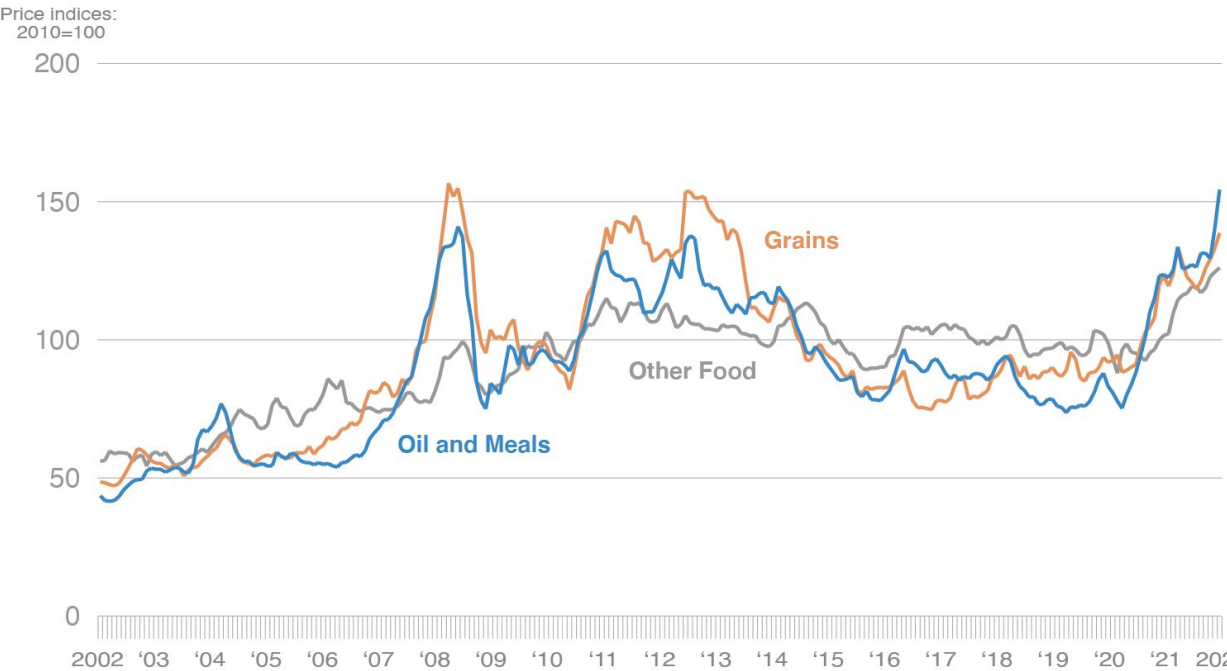
What does Justice and strong institutions mean?

Agricultural Commodity Prices Near Record Levels



In Ukraine more than 6.3 million people have left the country because of war. This war has also affected us. Palm oil and wheat prices have risen by two-thirds, natural gases and fertilizer prices have more than doubled! This will affect people in poorer countries who can now afford less food because of prices rising.

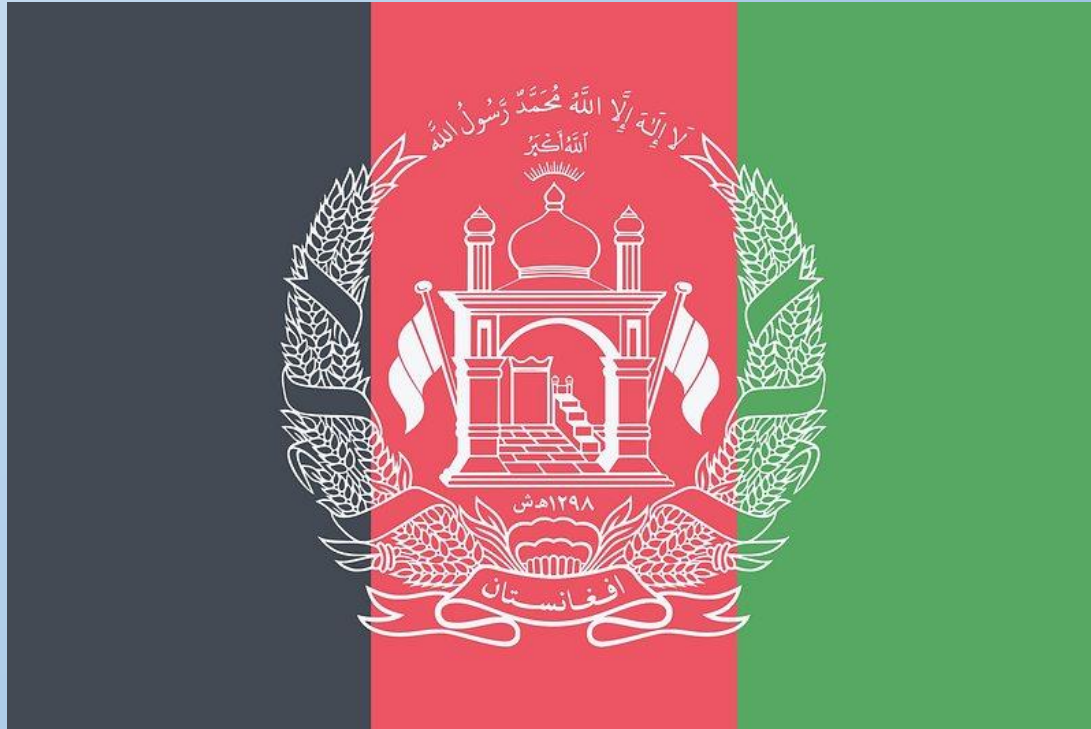
Gaza

In Gaza 60% of homes have been destroyed because of war. There are 625,000 school aged children and none of these children are going to school. No universities have survived the war. 21 hospitals are not working, 13 are partly working and 2 are minimally working.



Afghanistan

Rights in Afghanistan are severely restricted, especially for women. They can only go to very few public spaces and must be accompanied by their husbands. There are almost no jobs that they can hold. Girls over the age of eleven are not allowed to be educated.



Iraq

Women's rights have decreased hugely in the past few years. They can not integrate in society. Women in Iraq are forced into more traditional roles.



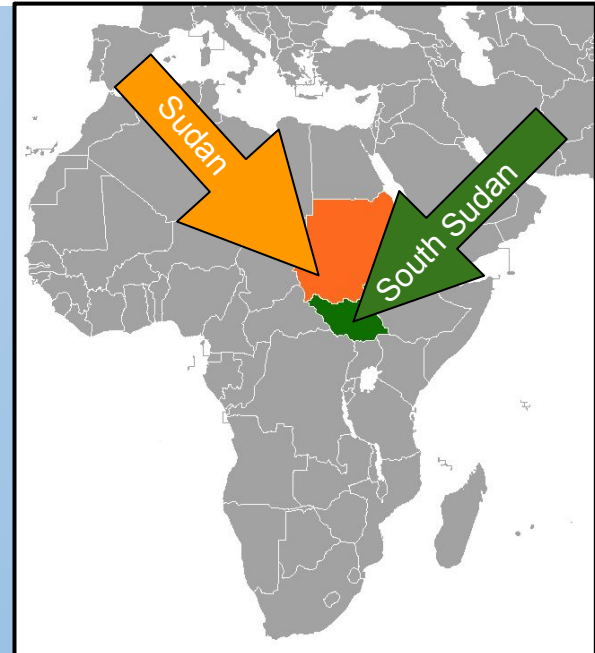
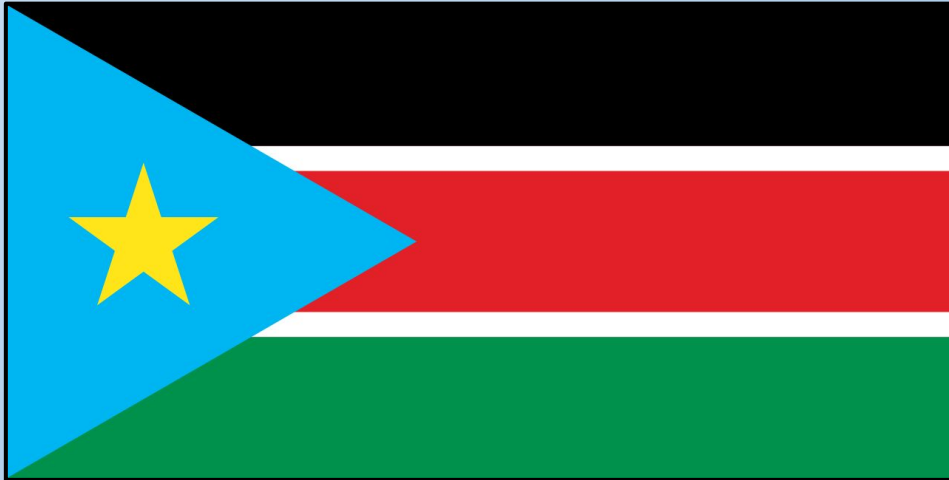
Russia

The laws in Russia say you have right to a fair and public trial but, a lot of governmental trials are interfered by people who persuade the jury to end the trial the way they want.



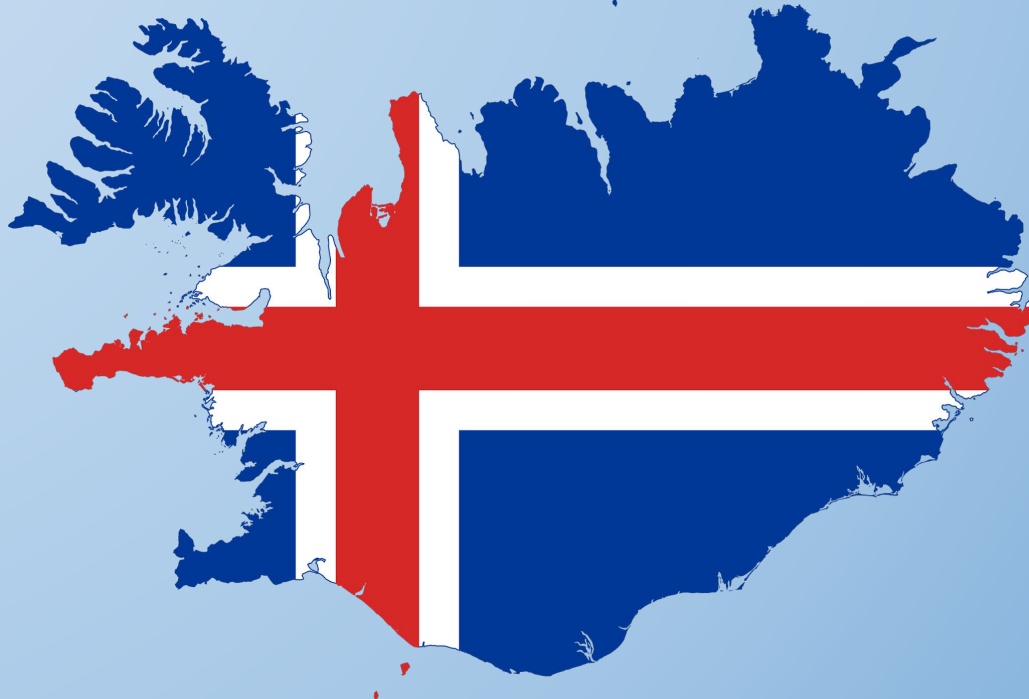
South Sudan

South Sudan is mostly undeveloped and one of the least developed countries. Most cities have no electricity or running water. They only have 10,000km of there roads paved!



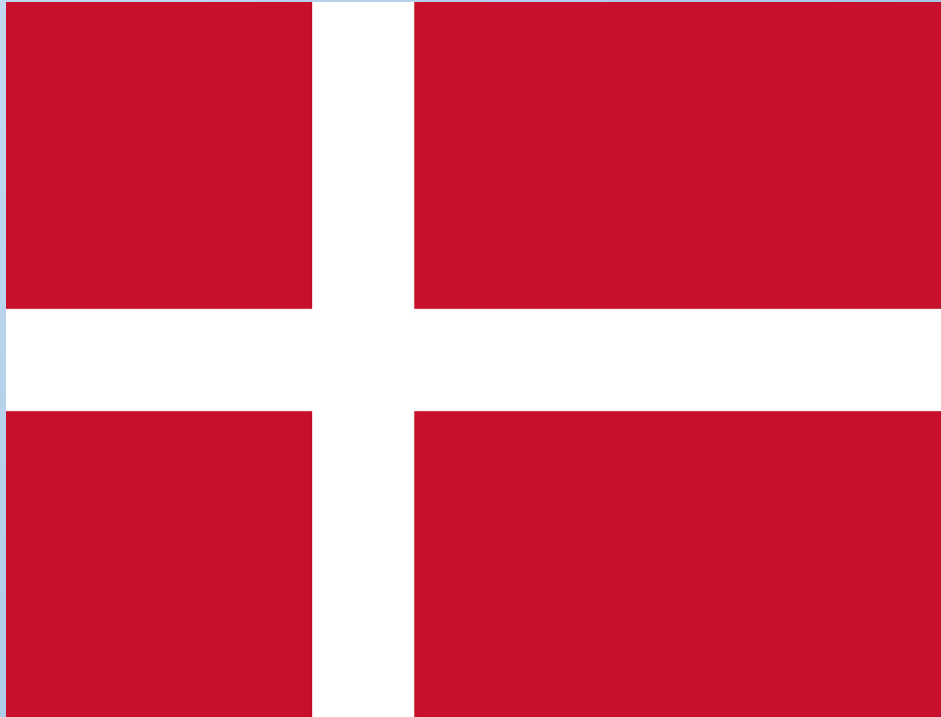
Iceland
